-PLEASE NOTE-

For purposes of returning to volunteering, if you have experienced a COVID-19 infection and:

- 1. It has been more than ten days since you became symptomatic; and
- 2. Your symptoms have improved; and
- 3. You've not had a fever for at least 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medications); then you're no longer considered infectious.

People who were hospitalized due to their illness or who are on very strong immunosuppressive medications, however, need to wait 20 days since their onset of symptoms, instead of the recommended 10 days.
